Angela Abela is a Professor and founding Head of the Department of Family Studies at the University of Malta where she teaches clinical psychology and family therapy trainees and supervises research. She chairs the National Centre for Family Research of the Malta Foundation for the Wellbeing of Society. She is a consultant for Parliament and the Maltese government in child and family policy. She is first author of the *Strategic Policy on Positive Parenting for Malta* (2016-2024) and currently sits on the inter-ministerial task force responsible for its implementation. Angela has served as an expert for the Council of Europe for many years and has also published widely in the area. She is an associate editor of *Clinical Child Psychology and Psychiatry*, an international advisory editor of *Contemporary Family Therapy*, is on the editorial board of *Children Australia* and is an associate editor on *Familles et Societe*, on the Algerian Scientific Journal Platform.
