Juri Krivzov graduated from the Radboud University Nijmegen and from Leiden University in the Netherlands in clinical psychology. Afterwards he worked in Fliedner Hospital in Ratingen, Germany in a psychosomatic therapy- and outpatient unit. In 2016, he moved to Ghent, Belgium to work on the Single Case Archive project - a unique collection of case studies in psychotherapy. Since 2018 he started his PhD there with the topic "Interpersonal Dynamics and Therapeutic Relationships in Patients with Functional Somatic Disorders". Thereby, he works with qualitative and mixed methods from psychodynamic and attachment perspective. He is especially interested in case study methodology and metasynthesis.

Reitske Meganck completed her PhD on validity of alexithymia measures in 2009. From the start of her career she was interested in mixed methods and case study methodology. She is one of the originators of the Ghent Psychotherapy Study – an RCT with emphasis on combination of qualitative and quantitative data. She is also one of the originators of the Single Case Archive project - a unique collection of case studies in psychotherapy. Next to her research activities, she is also a supervisor, a postdoctoral psychotherapy trainer, and a psychotherapist in private practice, working from Freudian-Lacanian perspective.
